Aims:

Representation: To serve as the voice of the school, ensuring that students have a platform to voice their opinions, concerns, and suggestions.

Enhancement of School Life: To improve the overall school experience for all students by identifying areas for development and introducing positive change.

Actions:

Regular Meetings: The council meets routinely (every 2 weeks) to plan events, and deliberate on student suggestions from our suggestion box.

Feedback Mechanisms: suggestion boxes, surveys, or forums where students can express their opinions and concerns.

Event Organisation: Planning and executing events, fundraisers, and initiatives that cater to the interests and welfare of the student body.

Liaison with School Management: Regularly updating and collaborating with school staff and management to advocate for student needs and implement changes.

Awareness Campaigns: Organising fundraisers around events such as Children in Need (November).

Budget Management: Overseeing funds allocated to the council, ensuring transparent and beneficial use of resources.

Communication: Keeping the students informed of council decisions, upcoming events, and general school updates through newsletters, announcements, social media and meeting minutes.
