<b>HISTORY</b>	<b>'What can we learn from Ancient Civilizations?'</b> An overview study of the ancient civilizations (Sumer, Indus Valley, Egypt and the Shang Dynasty) and a comparison of their achievements.	<b>'What was life like in Ancient Egypt?'</b> A more in depth look at life in Ancient Egypt – Daily life, pharaohs, gods, religion, achievements (pyramids, tombs and treasures. Using sources to learn about the past.		<b>'Would the Vikings do anything for power and money?'</b> A study of the Viking era in Britain looking at their daily life, invasions and battles.		
<b>GEOGRAPHY</b>	<b>'Is Warrington a good place to settle?'</b> A look at why Warrington may be a good place to settle and the ever-changing residential landscape. Children will learn about its close proximity to major cities and explore land use such as the OMEGA industrial estate. Comparison to other areas of land use around the world linked to their locations.		<b>'Why is the Amazon and the Rainforest so important?'</b> A look at the Amazon river and rainforest and why it is so vital to our planet. Children to look at the physical features, natural resources and use of the river.		<b>'How are our coasts changing?'</b> A look at how the physical coastal features of our world are changing over time – coastal erosion, plastic pollution, melting ice caps etc.
