School improvement Priorities for 2025-27

These are the main areas we will be focusing on:

- To improve writing outcomes across the school through the implementation of recommendations from the DfE Writing Framework and the Early Years Revised Framework.
- To develop teaching and learning practices through the implementation of a programme of instructional coaching for teaching staff.
- To further develop an assessment system for primary foundation curriculum subjects and science.
- To remove barriers for pupils with Special Educational Needs through the use of technology.
- To improve whole school attendance through the implementation of an early intervention strategy for pupils with attendance between 95% and 90%.
- To ensure consistency of approach from all staff regarding the school's positive behaviour policy to ensure pupil behaviour is exemplary.
- To continue to support the mental health and wellbeing of pupils through enhancing our offer.
- To implement the TCAT Digital Strategy and ensure preparedness for our pupils to thrive in a digital world.
